Tier status for Gyms and Fitness Centers

Moderate (orange) – Capacity must be limited to **25%**

Warehouse – 15 people total

Garage – 5 people total

Minimal (yellow) – **CURRENT TIER**

- Capacity must be limited to **50%**

Warehouse – 30 people total

Garage – 10 people total

MASK GUIDANCE AND COVID COMPLIANCE

At SGLA, masks are **required** to be worn at all times in the studios and common areas with the exception of active filming of on camera talent, or solo practice.

RENTER PREPARATION AND CLEANING PROCEDURES

Here are the basic procedures taken in preparation for rentals of the space for rehearsal, filming, and classes.

BEFORE AND AFTER EACH RENTAL:

- Sanitize dance floors
- Sanitize high touch areas in bathrooms

BEGINNING / END OF DAY:

- Clean and sanitize bathrooms and common spaces
- Sanitize dance floors

For these reasons, we ask that booking requests allow for 10-minute turnovers of the space so our team can prepare accordingly. *
